**MATCH REPORT**

Yesterday evening (Wednesday 24th June) saw the club play it's first ever cup fixture in the South Wales Full Toss Cup against Glenwood. In a thrilling and keenly contested 18 over match at Central Park, Centurions edged home by one run to secure their place in the semi finals of the inaugural Full Toss Cup. .

Having been put into bat by Glenwood, the tone for an excellent all-round Centurions performance was set by openers Lewis and Howard, who put on a spritely first wicket stand of 32 off just 5 over's. Bromiley and Lewis maintained the tempo before the former was run out by a fine throw from the boundary, Lewis retiring on 32 after a typically dashing innings. The run rate never dropped as Coombs (18 not out) worked the ball around to great effect, providing the platform for aggressive hitting towards the end of the innings by Mansell (14) and Matt Ball (17 not out), with some well-struck boundaries taking the score to a fine 116 off 18 over's.

With a strong bowling line-up confident of defending the target, Centurions got off to a great start in the field as Phillips and Bromiley produced a superb opening salvo of hostile and accurate fast bowling, Phillips bowling Harris with a snorter. Discipline was maintained by first change bowlers Matt Ball (1-19) and Hibberd (0-15), who kept the run rate down so that Glenwood never quite got ahead, Ball having the tenacious Hilsden caught nonchalantly at mid-off by Shearer, whose captaincy was inspired, first bringing Phillips (3-15) back to pick up two more wickets clean bowled to deliveries of perfect length, and then recalling Bromiley (1-6) who bowled Dobson with a beauty.

Once danger-man Lloyd Sutton was out after a fine innings to a good catch by Phillips off Shearer (1-23), Centurions looked clear favourites. However, as the tension mounted and mistakes crept into Centurions' fielding, some impressive strokeplay from Jarman left Glenwood needing 4 off Shearer's last delivery to win. Captain and fielders kept their head, restricting Glenwood to 2 and leaving Centurions victorious by a single run.

Credit goes to both sides for producing a superb cricket match, with many agreeing in the clubhouse afterwards that this was one of the best games they'd been involved in. Centurions will now play the Welsh Assembly Government (who beat Cardiff Bay Barbarians) in the semi final on w/c 20th July with the exact date and venue to be confirmed. Confidence is high that if this level of performance can be maintained then we can all dream of lifting the trophy itself in August. Match report written by "*the mystery pen*".
